ABOUT CFEH

CFEH is an initiative of Guide Dogs NSW/ACT and UNSW and aims to reduce preventable blindness by identifying eye disease before irreversible vision loss occurs. CFEH removes financial barriers to accessing advanced ocular imaging by providing all services free of charge.

CFEH operates from two Sydney locations:

- University of New South Wales (UNSW) Kensington
- The Sutherland Hospital (TSH) Caringbah

CFEH specialises in:

- -Glaucoma
- -Age-related Macular Degeneration
- -Eye conditions related to diabetes
- -Cataracts

- -Eye manifestations of general conditions (e.g. high blood pressure)
- -Retinal or optic-nerve diseases
- -Diseases affecting the cornea

What to expect

You have been referred by your eye health practitioner for further specialised testing to investigate an irregularity in your eye(s). Or they may want to monitor your eye health if you have certain risk factors.

You will be contacted by CFEH to schedule your appointment, if you do not hear within five working days, please contact the Centre. Appointment time will depend on the services you have been referred for, typically appointments last 30 minutes to 2 hours.

Clinic opening hours are Monday to Friday 9-5 for UNSW location and Wednesdays and Fridays 9-5 at Sutherland Hospital location.

The results are sent to your referring practitioner and you will be referred back to them for results (you may require a routine follow up at CFEH).

WHAT TO BRING

- Medicare card
- Sunglasses (your eyes may be dilated during the appointment and sensitive to light for a few hour aftewards)
- If you wear spectacles, please bring them to the appointment
- If you wear contact lenses, please wear spectacles to the appointment and bring your contact lenses with you
- Medical history including any history of family illness
- Current or previous medication and any details of past surgeries

CFEH UNSW, Kensington

CFEH is located in Sydney's eastern suburbs on the Kensington campus of The University of New South Wales. The Centre is best accessed via Gate 14 on Barker Street and is situated on the ground floor of the Rupert Myers Building (South Wing). CFEH has free parking within a short walk of the Centre.

CFEH satellite clinic operates at The Sutherland Hospital (TSH), co-located within the Eye Clinic, near the main reception.
