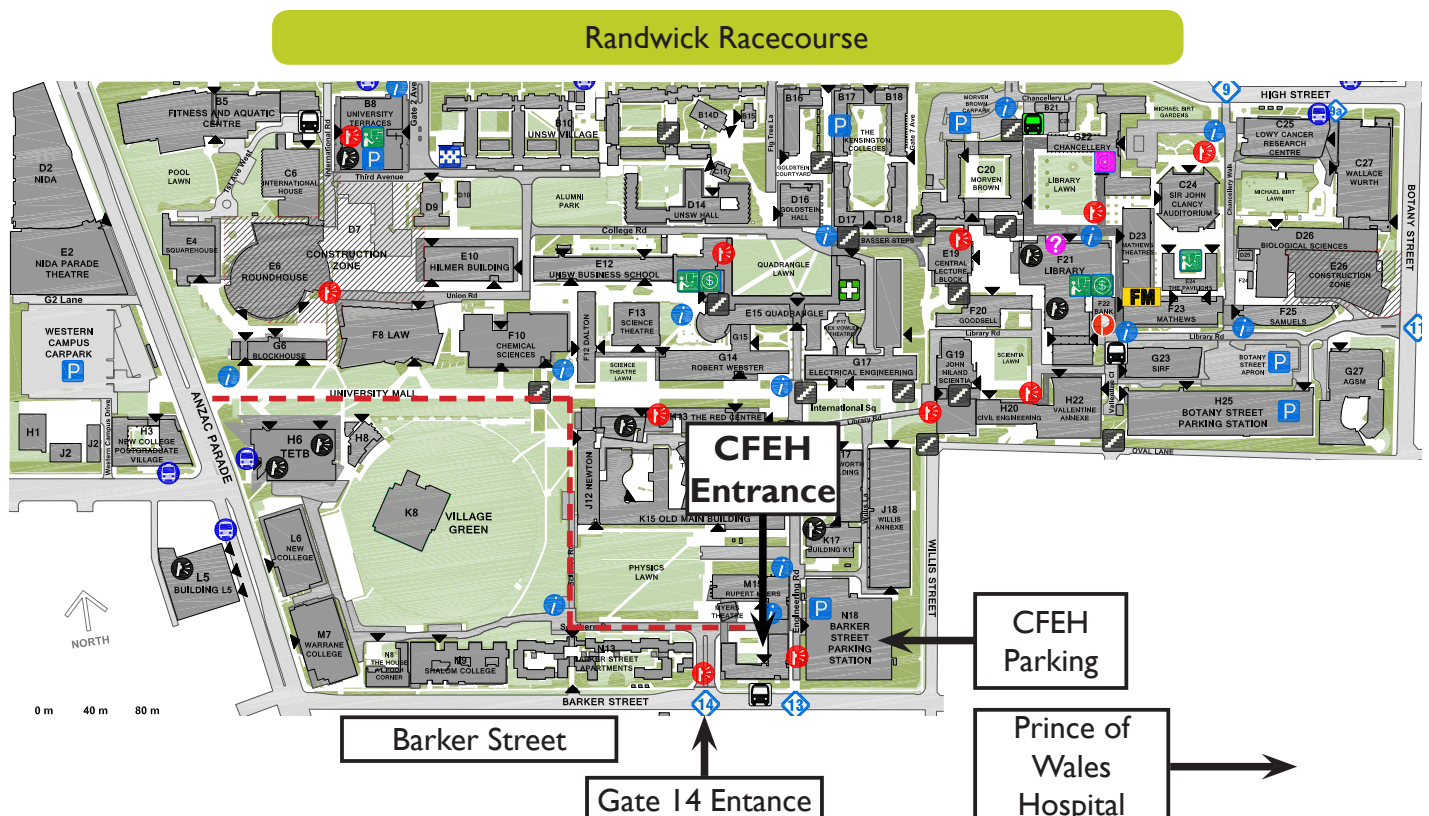

## LOCATION

Centre for Eye Health (CFEH) is located in Sydney's eastern suburbs on the Kensington campus of University of New South Wales (UNSW). CFEH is best accessed via Gate 14 on Barker Street and is situated on the ground floor of the Rupert Myers building (South Wing).

Allocated parking is available within short walking distance.

## Via Car

---

Prior to driving, please familiarise yourself with the test that will be performed. Your pupils may be dilated, which can impair your vision and influence your ability to drive after the tests.

## Street address

---

As the Centre is located within UNSW, navigation systems may not accept the address provided. If this is the case, please use the address of the building opposite CFEH instead:

52 Barker Street, Kingsford 2032

## Parking

---

When you arrive at Gate 14 on Barker Street, turn right at the T-intersection and follow the road into the multi-story car park (Barker Street Parking Station). On the **ground level**, you will find 6 allocated spots which have green paint on the ground and the CFEH logo on the wall (front to kerb parking only).

Collect a parking voucher from reception (located in the building just before the car park entrance) and display on the dashboard of your car.

Please only drive to level 5 if there are no CFEH spaced available and you're unable to find street parking. It is paid parking and you are required to pay at the meter before leaving the car park.

Alternatively, street parking is available around the University, however, please be aware that the majority is one hour parking only and therefore not recommended due to appointment durations.

## Via Public Transport

---

Infoline for buses and trains is 131 500.  
Buses are pre-paid, please use an Opal card.

### Bus to UNSW from Central Station

Bus numbers: 393 and 395 from Eddy Avenue (Stand C) opposite Central Station.  
Drop off on Anzac Parade, near the main University walkway.

### Bus to UNSW from Circular Quay

Bus numbers: 391, 392, 394, 396, 397 and 398.  
Drop off on Anzac Parade, near the main University walkway.

### Bus to UNSW from Bondi Junction

Bus numbers: 400 and 410.  
Drop off on Anzac Parade, near the main University walkway.

## Once you've reached UNSW:

Walking from Anzac Parade Bus Stop:

You can either walk through the University campus following the campus map on the first page (red lines).

Or you can walk down Anzac Parade (away from High Street) and turn left onto Barker Street, entering the University through Gate 14.
